The beauty of Kalesma lies in the simple moments, like enjoying a glass of assyrtiko (a Greek white wine) at sunset with a gentle breeze. With authentic Greek hospitality and a distinct sense of Cycladic design and flair, Kalesma is the chosen hotel for those who want to skip the Mykonos party scene in favor of languid sunny days. It will be hard to leave this estate-like hillside hotel, which has a total of 27 accommodations—including the spectacular seven-bedroom Leto Villa, which wouldn't look out of place in a design magazine.

There are three dining outposts: the all-day restaurant Pere Ubu, the Pere Ubu pool bar, and the Aloni Sunset Lounge. Pere Ubu specializes in fresh Greek cuisine, particularly mezzes, and there's a phenomenal Greek wine list for those who want a local taste. The newest addition to the young hotel is the Kalesma Spa, which has two rooms for face and body treatments using celebrity cult-favorite skincare line Dr. Barbara Sturm, a cryotherapy area, and a hammam.
